Lewiston Public Schools, in collaboration with the Auburn School Department, is seeking proposals for contracted services. A contracted service provider is needed to deliver mental health services to increase the identification, referral and coordination of services for middle and high school youth.

Mental health services include activities such as implementing the TeenScreen program in the Lewiston/Auburn middle schools, increasing capacity to conduct mental health screening in the high schools, working closely with the Director SS/HS to develop a school-based mental health network that ensures the provision of mental health services in the schools and referral to community-based services, and developing evidence-based guidelines, models, resources and policy considerations for school-based mental health services.

This request for contracted services is open to nonprofit organizations and profit-making organizations willing to waive profits and fees.
