Lewiston Public Schools, in collaboration with the Auburn School Department, is a recent recipient of a Safe Schools/Healthy Students Initiative grant and is seeking proposals for contracted services.

Early childhood services are needed to implement the Healthy Families America and Nurturing Parenting Program. Healthy Families America is a voluntary home visitation program designed to promote healthy families and children through child development services and parenting education. The Nurturing Parenting Program is a family-centered program designed to build nurturing skills as alternatives to abusive parenting and child-rearing attitudes and practices.

Substance abuse services are needed to deliver the Families in Action program to middle school students, ages 11-14 and their families and to implement substance abuse prevention services. The Families in Action program is a family-based alcohol, tobacco and other drug abuse prevention program. The substance abuse prevention services must incorporate multiple strategies in multiple domains including peer/individual, family, school, and community.

Eligibility

This request for contracted services is open to nonprofit organizations and profit-making organizations willing to waive profits and fees.

All proposals must be received by April 9, 2008, 4:00 p.m. EST
