

## Measures of Academic Progress (NWEA) 2008-2009

*Growth* is the percent of students who achieved targeted growth in the first administration of the Measures of Academic Progress (NWEA).

*Proficiency* is the percent of students who are expected to meet or exceed state standards on the Maine Educational Assessment according to the NWEA alignment study.

(Language Usage is not a category for Annual Yearly Progress, therefore there is no percentage of proficiency reported. Lewiston High School does administer the MEA, so there is no percentage of proficiency at that level.)
